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#### Modern Environmental & Tribal Eras Converge

1970 Pres. Nixon calls for Policy of Tribal Self-Determination

1970 Pres. Nixon creates EPA

1970 Clean Air Act (cooperative federalism born)

1972 Clean Water Act (State Water Quality Standards)

1972 Indian Education Act (tribal advisory role)

1974 Safe Drinking Water Act

1975 Indian *Self-Determination* & Education Assistance Act

1976 Resource Conservation & Recovery Act

# Tribal Environmental Self-Determination via EPA Cooperative Federalism

Amendments authorizing EPA to "treat tribes as states" (TAS) for primacy of various regulatory cooperative federalism programs

1986 Safe Drinking Water Act

1987 Clean Water Act (Tribal Water Quality Standards)

1990 Clean Air Act

[not RCRA]

#### Current Regulatory Programs on Indian Reservations

**574** Federally Recognized Tribes


300 "Eligible" Tribes (w/Reservations)

74 Tribes Treated as States

46 Tribes w/approved Water Quality Standards (WQS)


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15% Indian Country (IC) Waters Protected



#### WQS: The Foundation of the Clean Water Act

- 1. WQS set goals for quality of specific waterbodies
  - Designate desired uses (aquatic ecosystems, recreation, etc.)
  - > Set criteria protecting uses
  - > Set antidegradation requirements
- 2. WQS influence stringency of pollution permit conditions
- 3. WQS control local certification of federal permits
- 4. WQS determine waterbody "impairment"



#### Consequences of Gap in WQS $\rightarrow$ Uncertainty

Regulated firms: Which WQS applicable on Reservations? Upstream of Reservations? Risk of citizen suits?

States: Which WQS are applicable upstream of Reservations? Health risks to State residents in and downstream of Reservations?

<u>Tribes</u>: Water quality trends? Health risks to tribal citizens? Risks to cultural values?

<u>EPA</u>: Environmental injustice? Discharge federal trust responsibility?

#### Federal "Baseline" WQS for Indian Reservations

EPA-developed national WQS program applicable to Reservations lacking TWQS

- Designated uses: consumption of fish & aquatic resources, cultural uses of water & aquatic resources
- Numeric criteria: tied to Indigenous consumption rates
- Narrative criteria: "water must be free from pollutants that prevent growth of plants harvested for cultural & traditional purposes"

#### Tribal Consultation Complete

<u>Summer 2021</u>: Listening sessions, tribal organizations & individual tribes' input

Overwhelming support; National Tribal Water Council urges full promulgation for tribal sovereignty & federal trust responsibility

> Still TAS option: TWQS replace Baseline WQS

Summer 2022: expect Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for public comment

### Related Federal Implementation Proposal

Protecting tribal reserved rights via WQS outside Reservations

- Tribal subsistence & cultural rights in aquatic resources reserved by treaty, statute, Executive Order
- Possible regulatory revision requiring protection of tribal reserved rights for approval of State WQS
  - Disapproved SWQS can be replaced by FWQS
