- LAW 359 (Mediation)
 - Course description: This class examines all aspects of mediation, including the challenges, benefits, skills, and ethic requirements related to a mediator’s role. The course focuses intently on developing practical skills that enhance students’ abilities to be persuasive and influential communicators. Using role plays, students learn how to handle difficult conversations and to facilitate dialogue between multiple individuals. Students also develop the ability to coach individuals through conflicts in mediation. Through the use of experienced mediation coaches, students receive feedback and individualized instruction during the roleplay exercises. Students complete multiple assignments, including creating a mediator’s opening, analyzing and contrasting two mediations, and preparing a mediation representation plan. By completing the course students earn a certificate that may enable service, after completion of additional requirements, on court mediation rosters.
