Fall 2024 Book List

Last week I shared with you the course schedule for the upcoming year. Although we won't be launching registration until mid-July, this email contains very important information – your fall book list!

As a reminder from our Week #5 email, as first year law students (commonly referred to as 1L's), you will all be required to take the same 5 courses which were highlighted in **yellow** on the course schedule.

For fall 2024 you take:

- Law182 - Civil Procedure
- Law120 - Contracts I
- Law180 - Professional Foundations
- Law111 - Torts
- Law 160 - Lawyering Skills I*
 - *With the exception of Lawyering Skills I & II, all classes have one section so all incoming 1L's will be in class together. Lawyering skills will be broken off into 5 sections which will be determined mid-July.

The book list for Fall 2024 courses is attached, so you can begin purchasing your books for all your courses except for Lawyering Skills I.
